"BE INSPIRED AWARDS" from Bentley Systems Inc. for OSX3 FPSO topside engineering

L&T Valdel Engineering Limited (LTV) stood among the top 3 at the prestigious
"Be-Inspired Awards" competition (organized by Bentley Systems, Inc. on
October 28-31 in London) recognizing outstanding achievements in
infrastructure design, construction and operation. The event was part of the
Year in Infrastructure 2013 Conference, a global gathering of leading executives
in the world of infrastructure design, construction and operations.

LTV submitted details of its experience in the structural engineering of OSX-3 FPSO project in the "Innovation in Offshore Engineering category". OSX-3 FPSO is located in the Santos Basin, off the coast of Brazil. It is turret-moored in a maximum water depth of 110m and is designed to produce and treat around 100,000 barrels of crude oil per day. The challenge was to complete the topside design of 15 modules and 10 pipe-racks within a record schedule of 10 months. The size and nature of the project and the challenges faced by LTV also found special mention in the keynotes of Greg Bentley (Bentley's CEO) and Malcolm Walter (Bentley's COO).
